How to Pledge and Donate Online

from there click on the “Giving” tab from the drop-down menu on a mobile device or page menu on a computer.

From this page you can click the “Donate” button which will redirect you to a new tab.

In the first section of this page, you can input your Pledge amount and assign a monthly withdrawal date. Proceed by clicking “continue” at the bottom of the page.

On this next page you will be prompted to input your personal as well as payment information. If you select a password here you will have the flexibility of canceling and adjust recurring payments on your own in the future.

Lastly click process at the bottom of the page and as easy as that you have made your pledge. Going forward your contributions will automatically be offered on your behalf.

...offering one’s self to God as He offered Himself to us.

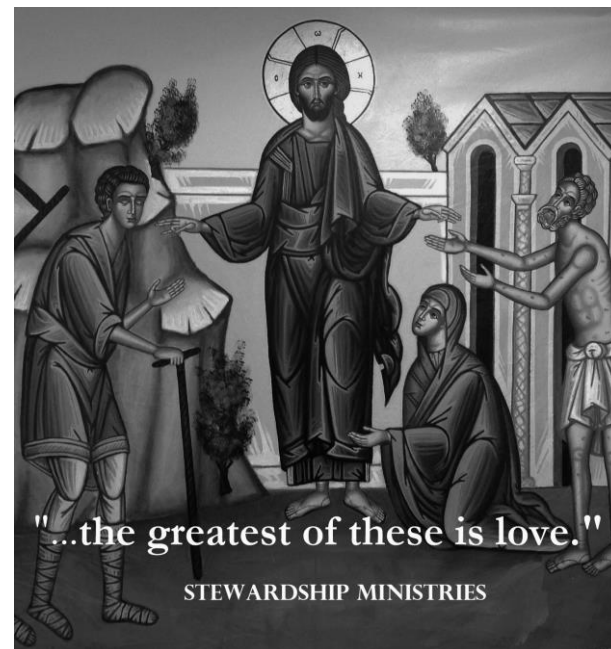
