#### Our Patron Saint Demetrios Great Vespers

Every year on October 26 we celebrate the Feast of our Patron Saint Demetrios the Great Martyr, Wonderworker, and Myroblete. On that day, whatever day of the week it may fall on, we celebrate the Orthros or Matins Service, followed by the Divine Liturgy. However, the celebration of the Feast of our Patron Saint actually begins on October 25<sup>th</sup>. Since the Liturgical Day begins at sunset, not sunrise, the feast begins at the celebration of the Great Vespers Service on the eve of the Feast, October 25<sup>th</sup>. On a side note, the Liturgical Day begins at sunset because of the Biblical reference in Genesis 1:5 "And there was evening and there was morning, one day" – the



darkness (evening) came before the light was created by God (morning).

At any rate, the Feast of our Patron Saint begins with the Great Vespers Service on October 25<sup>th</sup> at 7pm, and since the Divine Liturgy on October 26<sup>th</sup> takes place in the morning when most people are forced to be at work, it is the Great Vespers Service that affords us the greatest opportunity to gather in worship and celebrate our parish Feast Day. Unfortunately, most of us squander that opportunity to come together and celebrate the Great Vespers Service of our Patron Saint.

Saint Demetrios is our Patron Saint, which means that our Church Temple and our entire community are dedicated in his honor. This means, in turn, that we as a community and as individuals, have a special place in *HIS* heart. While all our prayers are directed ultimately to Christ, we can ask our Patron Saint Demetrios to help us, protect us, and fight for us. As our patron, he loves us, and will do everything he can to defend us and fight for our salvation, how can we ignore his Feast? Please make every possible attempt to attend the Great Vespers and Divine Liturgy of our beloved Saint Demetrios – he fights for us every day, please take advantage of this opportunity to fight for *HIM*.


