#### Do You Have 20/20 Vision? – by Fr. Cosmas

As we get older, our eyes can begin to let us down. We stop seeing things as clearly as we used to, and we find ourselves squinting without the aid of glasses or contacts. We no longer have 20/20 vision, as our eyes age like the rest of our bodies. This can also happen in other aspects of our life. We fail to see things clearly through the youthful eyes of hope, change and potential. We now see aspects of life through aged eyes that can be tainted by routine, stubbornness and obstinacy. This is especially true in the life of the Church.

This year our parish celebrates it's 90<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. And while it's important to look back, we also have to look ahead. Next year is 2020! We are living in the future! But what is our vision for the future of our Church? What is our vision for next year? Are we thinking about next year, and the potential to improve parish life? If we don't have 20/20 vision anymore, do we at least have 2020 vision? Or are we hoping and praying that nothing changes, and that things stay the same as they have for 90 years?

But what has really stayed the same for the past 90 years? We've changed church locations every 13 years on average, and priests every 7 years on average! We should be able to embrace change by now. But changes in parish life that really matter to the future survival of our church. We need to begin to embrace changes in mentality, that allow us to open our hearts and minds to the community around us.

We are no longer a fledgling, community of displaced persons in the first half of the 20<sup>th</sup> century, trying desperately to maintain our culture and ethnic identity. Our parish has changed. Everything has changed. We now have to embrace a new identity. We have to begin to see ourselves as missionaries and apostles. The word "apostle" means "one who is sent". We need to think of ourselves as being sent to a new land by Christ, to establish His Church, and witness the "Gospel" or "Good News". The Good News about salvation in Christ.

As we begin to look toward the future, I hope and pray that we can see clearly. That we have 2020 vision for our Church. That we no longer gaze through aged pupils of stubbornness and indifference. That we may begin to see the future clearly, and understand how to meet the needs of our ever-changing parish family. We have to ask ourselves, "What does Christ expect of us"?...to remain isolated and closed-off, or to welcome as many people as possible into His Church? He sees us as His apostles, sent by Him to bring countless others to His glory. Do we see things clearly, and in reference to the future? Do we have 2020 vision for our Church?


